SMALL GRANTS CHAMPIONING SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHS ACROSS THE WEST MIDLANDS

CRITERIA

- > Proposed activity must be based in the geographical area of the West Midlands Region of the United Kingdom.
- > Proposed activity must demonstrate tangible links to either one or more of the disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM).
- > Proposed activity must align with the Millennium Point Charitable objectives around the advancement of learning and education.
- > Activity must be delivered within 12-months of receiving funds.
- > Demonstrate measurable outcomes based on key performance indicators, metrics and impact against the project mission statement.
- > Funding can be used for start-up projects, to extend or develop an existing project or to purchase equipment or resources.
- > Existing projects applying for funding must significantly adapt or increase the lifespan of activities delivered previously. This development must be based on learnings, or expand the project to engage a new community, group or demographic.
