We will pay the tuition fees for one undergraduate degree at Birmingham City University's Faculty of Computing, Engineering and the Built Environment – equivalent to £27,000.

The faculty has over 20 different courses from engineering and architectural design to music technology, film production and video game design.

Top five applicants each year will receive skills development, leadership workshop, interview, public speaking and presentation training and opportunities to connect and work with industry-specific employers.

We'll then notify the top five who will go on to the next stage of the competition.

The second stage is an assessment day assessed by a panel of industry leaders.

Applicants must:

- Be aged 18 by 1st September 2021
- Do not currently have an undergraduate, or higher, qualification
- Have made an application to a qualifying course at Birmingham City University
